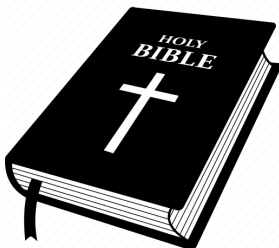


Socks and Undies Sundays return in January!

PASTOR HAS THE LAST WORD!

December 2023

Advent is a welcome season. The word "advent" means "coming" or "arrival". It is a season of preparation where we consider both the coming of God made flesh in Jesus Christ, and look for the second coming of Christ and the renewal of all things.

Advent is a season of small candle flames in the darkness, a season of waiting and watching and expecting, a season of hope. What do you hope for, dear church?

This year we have three short but potent weeks of the Advent season before Christmas Eve falls on a Sunday. Three weeks to contemplate, expect, and embody hope. Each Sunday will have a theme centered in hope: hope for God- with-us, hope for transformation, and hope for restoration.

We will sing portions of the hymn "All Earth is Hopeful (Toda la tierra)" at the end of each Advent worship service. This song, written by a Roman Catholic priest from Spain, gives voice to the Advent hope that all creation sings together--new life for all the world, freedom in Christ, God-with-us.
